In addition the *Biofeedback* issue published on August 18, 2014, which carried the article by Suzanne Grubb (V 39, N3, summer 2014, pg 6) describing this service has been downloaded 533 times.

**Analysis:** The statistics prove that the DBIO home pages have seen a lot of traffic. The numbers speak for themselves, but nevertheless several conclusions can be taken:

- Access is predominantly via <a href="http://dbiosla.org/">http://dbiosla.org/</a> (18,813 visits), rather than via <a href="http://bio.sla.org/">http://dbiosla.org/</a> (1,730) which is the Landing Site.
- There is interest in the history of the Division, since DBIO History page has been visited 890 times.
- The Systems Thinking Perspective has been visited 536 times as a result of DBIO offering a program at the Annual Meeting where Lorri A Zipperer's work "*Knowledge management in healthcare*" was discussed.
- The Volunteer for Service page has been visited 636 times.
